Secondly if an enrolment application is accepted, you will be provided with *Enrolment Form (Part B)*. Both steps must be completed with all requested supporting documents submitted in order to finalise your child's enrolment at our College. Part A should be completed by the end of Term 2 and Part B by the end of Term 3 to ensure smooth transition into our College for the start of 2025.
