OUR PROGRAM

Byford Secondary College has a strong belief that all students attending the College are an important part of our inclusive community. Students attend the College with a range of abilities and are supported with various diagnoses such as intellectual disabilities, physical disabilities, language disorders, mental health conditions and Autism Spectrum Disorder. They work in multi-level classes on individual learning programs

INTEGRATED FACILITY

The Education Support Program at Byford Secondary College is in a purpose built, state of the art building designed to support students with a range of complex cognitive, physical, medical, social and emotional needs. Our facilities include:

- a hydrotherapy pool with extensive hoisting facilities;
- a sensory garden and sensory room;
- a specialised kitchen with accessibility options;
- highly trained and experienced staff including a School Nurse and School Psychologist; and
- support by In-School Therapy Services.

SEN PROGRAM

Each child enrolled in the Education Support Program has a customised Individual Educational Plan (IEP). This is established in collaboration with families. Teachers deliver integrated curriculum topics including:

- Functional literacy and numeracy skills (money handling, using AAC devices to communicate);
- Social skills (seeking assistance, communicating with others, being part of a team, speaking on a phone);
- Health & Protective Behaviours;
- Life skills (cooking, cleaning, washing, and budgeting)
- Career development and workplace learning.

Students regularly participate in specialist classes such as Woodwork, Home Economics, Physical Education, Media Studies, Art, Dance and Music.
