OUR PROGRAM

Your child has the opportunity to be part of a unique instrumental music program only available in Western Australian public schools. Students can take advantage of free, small group lessons as well as having the opportunity to perform in ensembles and at a range of festivals. In addition to weekly small group instrumental lessons, students undertake music theory lessons and have opportunities to participate in enrichment music activities. These include students working collaboratively across year levels and with students from other schools.

Our College also offers the opportunity to students who are interested in learning an instrument, as a beginner, to apply to commence in the program. Students who are currently or have previously learnt an instrument through private tuition are also encouraged to apply. Students who apply will be required to audition and take an aptitude test. Successful candidates have the opportunity to study in the following instruments:

- Electric Guitar;
- Acoustic Guitar;
- Bass Guitar;
- Drums/Percussion;
- Saxophone; and
- Brass.

Please note that instruments on offer are subject to availability and demand and may change from year to year. Students enrolled in the instrumental program must continue until at least Year 10.

This program also allows for students who are already learning an instrument to continue with IMSS (Instrumental Music School Service). Students who are already enrolled in the IMSS program at Primary School are not required to complete the aptitude test/audition.
